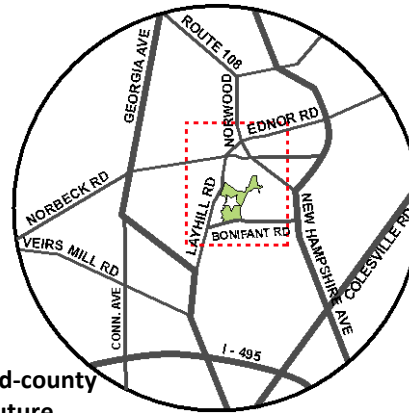

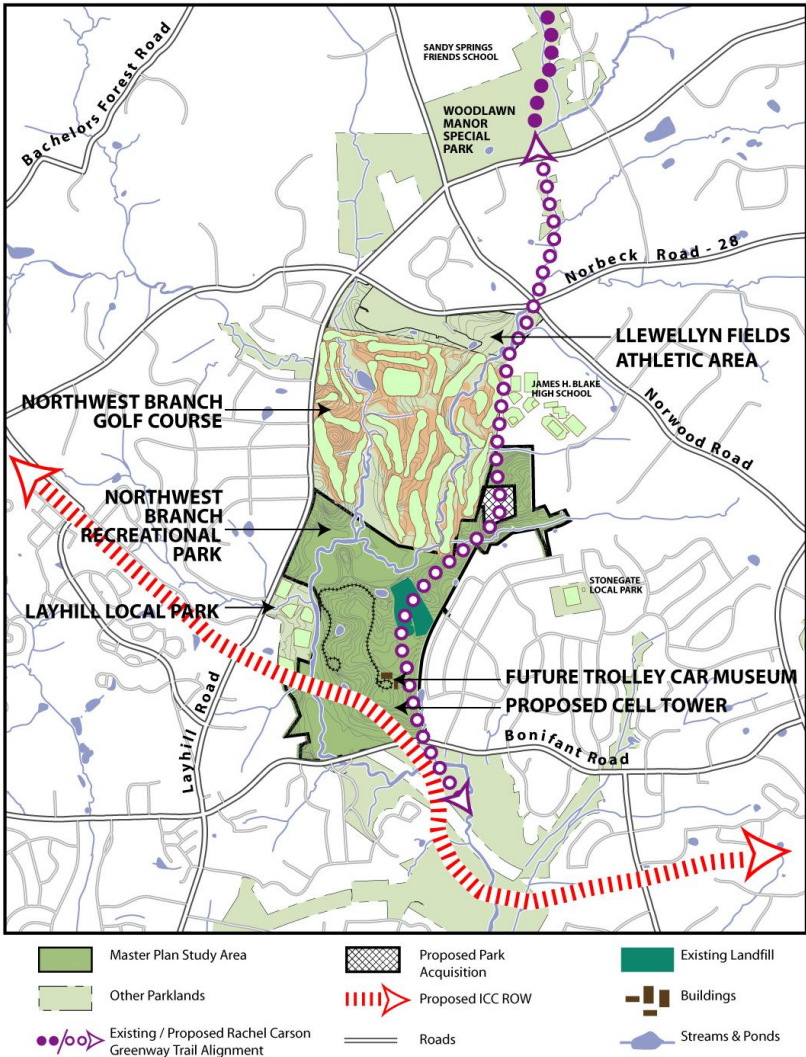

Purpose of the Plan

A master plan is needed at this time to provide a future vision and sketch plan for the undeveloped areas of Northwest Branch Recreational Park. The Plan will be coordinated with the many current proposals in and near the park including the Trolley Museum relocation, new Verizon Tower, ICC construction, the Rachel Carson Trail and other trail connections, Llewellyn Fields Athletic area, and other requests for facilities.

The major focus of the master plan will be to develop a concept plan for a family recreation area north of Bonifant Road that will complement the Trolley Museum Facilities, and preserve many areas for nature study and wildlife habitat. The Rachel Carson Trail will connect the park to Llewellyn Fields Athletic area on the Northern edge of the park, and a connection to the ICC trail will be studied.
