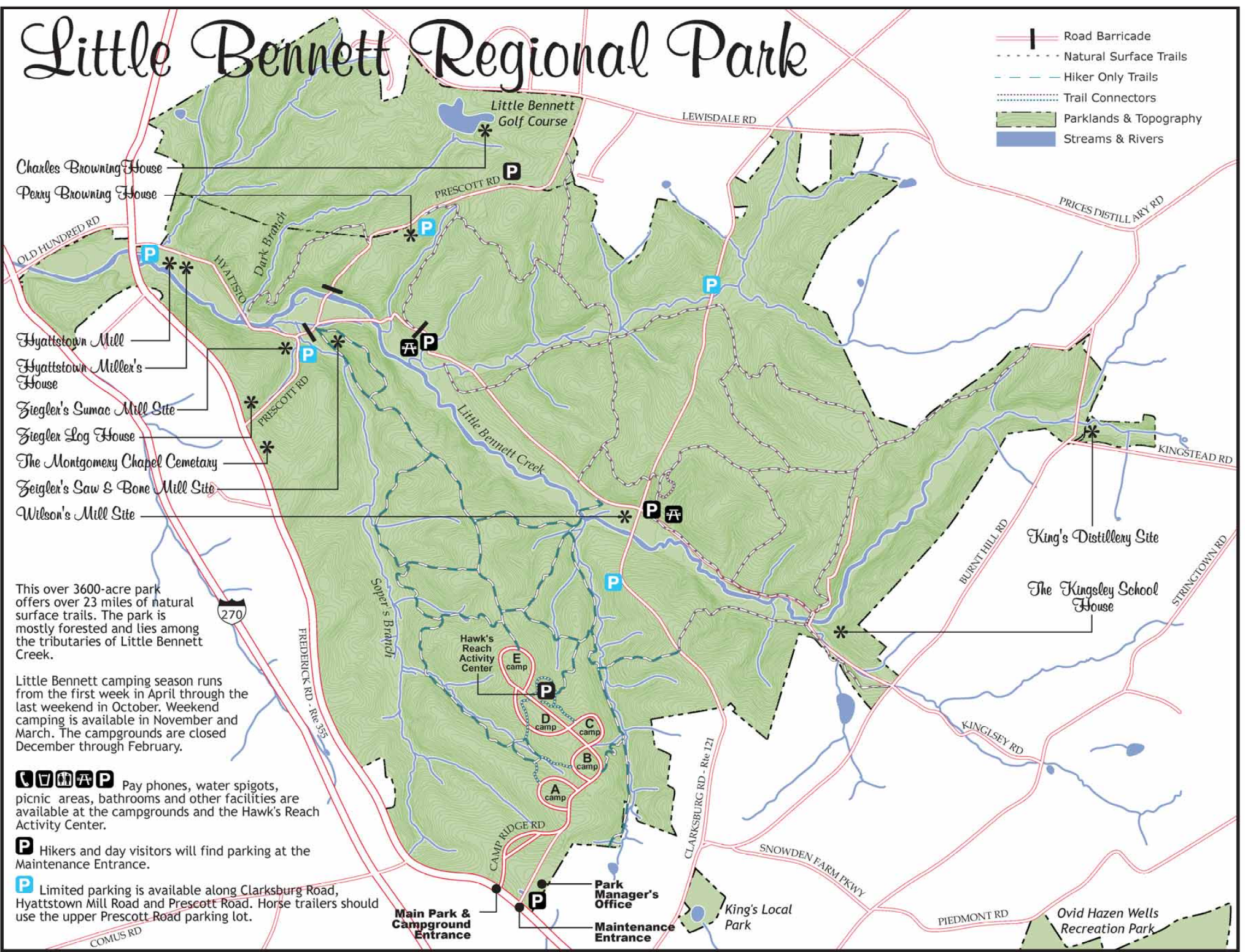
This over 3600-acre park offers over 23 miles of natural surface trails. The park is mostly forested and lies among the tributaries of Little Bennett Creek.

Little Bennett camping season runs from the first week in April through the last weekend in October. Weekend camping is available in November and March. The campgrounds are closed December through February.

 Pay phones, water spigots, picnic areas, bathrooms and other facilities are available at the campgrounds and the Hawk's Reach Activity Center.

 Hikers and day visitors will find parking at the Maintenance Entrance.

 Limited parking is available along Clarksburg Road, Hyattstown Mill Road and Prescott Road. Horse trailers should use the upper Prescott Road parking lot.
