



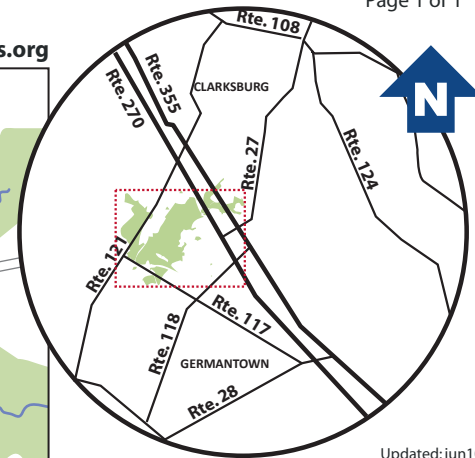
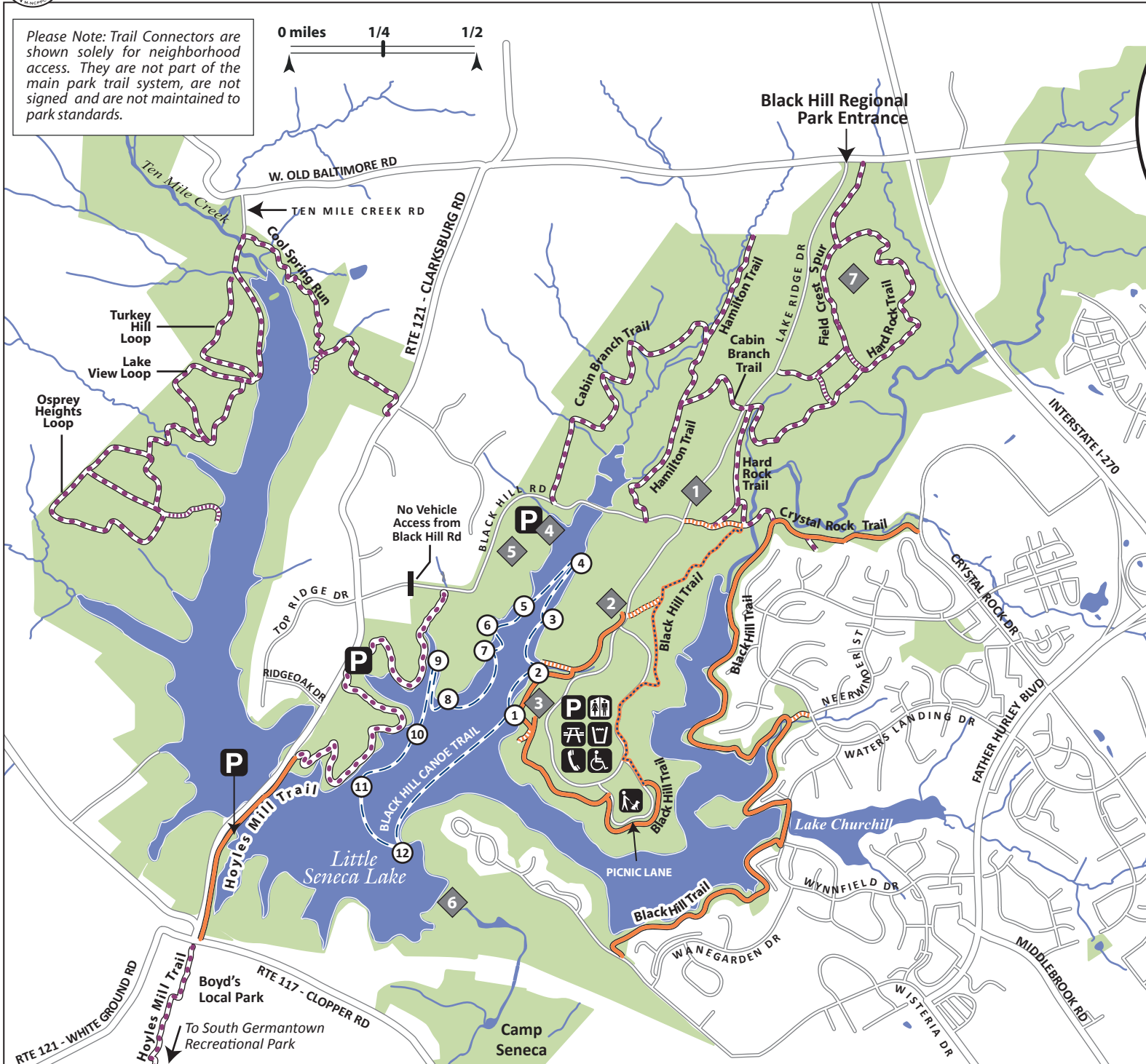
Black Hill Regional Park Trails
