July 12 – 16 9 am – 4 pm

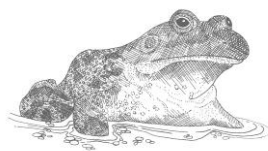
Find out about local wildlife! Learn about the daily activities of animals in different habitats through games, crafts and outdoor exploration.
