

MSHA Specifications Definitions

For any work on this project that does not include a technical specification in this project document, the work shall conform to Maryland Department of Transportation, State Highway Administration's (MSHA) Specifications entitled "Standard Specifications for Construction and Material" dated July 2008, Revisions thereof, or additions thereto.

DEFINITIONS

Wherever in State Specifications the following terms or abbreviations are used, the meaning shall be as follows:

"STATE" The word state shall mean Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - the changing from MSHA to Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission shall not be to the exclusion of MSHA and FWHA reviews.

"MSHA or ADMINISTRATION" The word "MSHA" (Maryland State Highway Administration) or "Administration" shall mean M-NCPPC (Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission)

"ENGINEER" Shall mean the Construction Manager for the Maryland-National Park and Planning Commission.

"MDE" Shall mean the Montgomery County Department of Permitting Services.

"PROJECT SCHEDULE" MSHA Section 109 shall only apply when a CPM Project Schedule item is included in the bid form. Otherwise, all Project Schedules shall conform to MSHA Section 110.

All references to material testing by the Engineer in the MSHA Specifications should be deemed to be the contractor's responsibility through a material testing lab that is acceptable by the Commission's Construction Manager.

If there are discrepancies between the method of measurement and payment stipulated in any sections of this contract document and MSHA specifications, the following will prevail:

1. Schedule of bid prices;
2. Commission specifications;
3. Plans;
4. MSHA specifications;
5. Standards of Industry
