

Black Hill Regional Park Trail Renovation Project
March 10, 2012 Field Walk

Greetings,

Please join the Parks Department on Saturday, March 10, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. (rain or shine) as we conduct a field walk to view locations for the placement of permanent safety fencing (see attached announcement). Staff will review each proposed location and discuss rationale for safety fencing. The group will meet across from the intersection of Neerwinder Street and Waters Landing Drive, northwest of Ambassador Drive crossing.

The "Rustic 3-Rail" wood fence option (Option #4) was determined to be the favored choice to be installed along the trail based upon the poll results and the expressed sentiments during the public meeting. The Parks Department has also agreed to omit the wire mesh backing as requested during the public meeting.
