#### ANNOUNCEMENT UPDATE!

Good afternoon folks.

Please join us on Wednesday, January 18, 2012 at 8:00 p.m. (following the Waters Landing Board of Directors meeting) to discuss poll results and fencing options. The meeting will be held at 20000 Father Hurley Blvd., Germantown, MD, 20874. If you have not had an opportunity to cast your vote in the on-line survey, please visit

and provide your input. We will also be soliciting input at the meeting Wednesday and looking for a show of hands for preferences among the frontrunners, so please plan to attend if possible. Attached is a chart of the current poll standings with over 100 votes cast.

Please note that as the restoration efforts in the recently constructed portion of the trail were completed, we re-inspected the final grades and determined a few additional areas where a safety barrier was needed. We are working to have those areas marked and temporary fencing installed in the field to provide an updated view of the ultimate fence locations. We will also be presenting the fence locations on GIS maps at the meeting.

We understand that there may be some confusion about safety fence locations for the second phase of construction (from Neerwinder Street south to Wisteria Drive). This area is beginning construction now, and there are silt fences and tree protection fences being placed along the entire length; however, those fences are only there for construction and do not represent the limits of permanent safety fences. We are working on identifying the areas of anticipated permanent fencing in the field and those areas will be included in the presentation Wednesday. Please note that as with the first phase of work just completed, the ultimate fence locations may need to be adjusted once the construction has been completed.

Thank you for the continued community interest in this project, and we look forward to meeting with you Wednesday.
