

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION HEARING **Preliminary Consultation** **Woodlawn Visitor Center**

The M-NCPPC, Montgomery Parks will consult with the Montgomery County Historic Preservation Commission to review semi-final design plans for the Woodlawn Visitor Center. The project, at 16501 Norwood Road, Sandy Spring, MD, proposes to rehabilitate the existing stone barn and carriage house and open the buildings to the public. The plans include exhibits focusing on the themes of the Underground Railroad, the Quaker Experience in Montgomery County, and the stone barn.

The Historic Preservation Commissioners will review and provide feedback on the work to ensure the plans are compatible with the historic setting. Members of the public are invited to provide comments on the historic nature of the work and may do so in-person or submit written comments in advance of the hearing.
