## Woodlawn Barn Visitor Center

Montgomery Parks, M-NCPPC, invites you to attend an open house presentation about the Woodlawn Barn Visitor Center. The site is located at the Woodlawn Cultural Special Park at the intersection of Norwood Road and Ednor Roads in Sandy Spring. Come peek into the barn and view the final design materials. Park staff will be available to answer questions.

The historic stone barn will be converted to hold exhibits and programs to tell the story of the Underground Railroad, the Quaker Heritage in Montgomery County, and the barn as an important artifact. It will provide heritage area information and be the trailhead for the Underground Railroad Experience Trail. The main attraction will be a multi-media audio-visual program in the upper levels of the barn.
