Proposed New Park: Seneca Crossing Local Park

Montgomery Parks, M-NCPPC, invites you to participate in a meeting to determine the design for a new park, Seneca Crossing Local Park. It is located along Brink Road at the intersection with Ridge Road (Route 27) in Germantown.

We will discuss site conditions and opportunities, and present 4 concepts that illustrate a variety of options and ideas for the park. Your input will be used to help us develop alternative plans for the park, which will be presented for additional public review at a later date.
