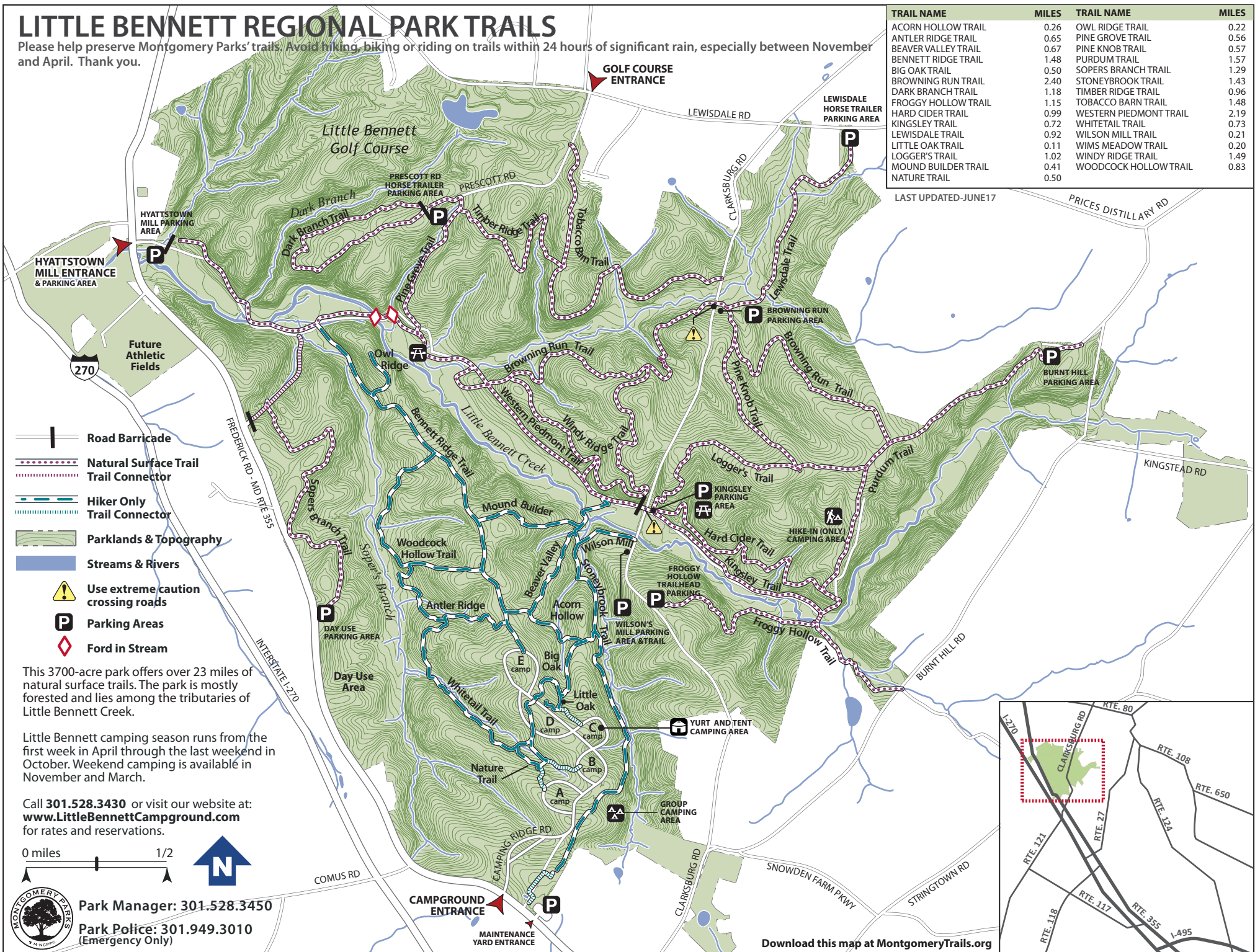


LITTLE BENNETT REGIONAL PARK TRAILS

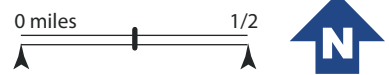
