

Little Bennett Campground Rules



1. Check in time 1pm; Check out Time 11am
2. 2-night minimum required on all sites
3. Quiet Hours 11pm – 7am
4. Cancellations/permit changes made in writing up to 14 days in advance of the reservation start date will be given a full refund. Refund request must be made to:

5. Cancellations/permit changes made in writing between 1 and 13 days in advance of the reservation start date will be charged a \$25 administrative fee. Refund request must be made to:

6. No refunds will be issued for cancellations/permit changes or early departures requested on or after the scheduled date of arrival.
7. Beer and wine are permitted at campsites only. Any alcohol containers must be concealed. No alcohol is permitted in common areas of the campground. No liquor is permitted on campground property.
8. Bath Houses open April through October; portable toilets onsite March and November with running water at all times at spigots throughout camping loops
9. The campground is not a day use area. Only permitted campers or registered visitors are allowed.
10. Gate code will only be given out upon check-in to registered campers
11. Permit holders are limited to a 14-day stay
12. Moving to a new site without approval is prohibited
13. No more than 2 tents OR 1 RV and 1 tent may be placed on one campsite
14. No more than 2 vehicles may be parked at any campsite
15. No more than 6 individuals may occupy one campsite (including registered visitors)
16. Campground visitors must register and pay at the Campground Booth or Camp Store to obtain vehicle tag and amenity wristbands. Only registered campers or registered visitors may use campground facilities or amenities
17. Groups up to 60 may rent the Group Camping Area. The only other group areas which may be rented are the Pavilion (40 capacity) and the Campfire ring (40 capacity). Groups may not gather in any other areas of the Campground. The Pavilion and Campfire Ring are only available to those who already have a Campground Permit.
18. Motor vehicles and/or camping vehicles must be parked on the parking pad of the permitted site
19. Children under age 13 must be under adult supervision
20. Picnic tables are not to be moved
21. Pets are permitted if kept on a leash. Pets must not be left unattended and waste must be cleaned up. No pets allowed in Yurt sites.
22. Washing vehicles, dishes, pots and pans at water outlets is prohibited. Hoses may not be permanently attached to any water outlet
23. Trash and recycling must be placed in the appropriate receptacles
24. Fires are permitted only in the grill or fire ring provided in your permitted site Firewood must fit inside of the ring. Fires must not be left unattended
25. Due to the spread of the tree-harming invasive species Emerald Ash Borer, firewood may NOT be brought into the Campground. You may purchase firewood at the Camp Store.
26. Cutting any standing tree is considered destruction of property and subject to criminal penalty
27. It is unlawful to cut, injure or mutilate any plant, tree or shrub or damage any structure, or equipment onsite
28. The use of chain saws for any reason is prohibited
29. It is unlawful to catch, injure, destroy or interfere in any way with wildlife
30. Nails, knives or other sharp devices may not be driven into any structure
31. It is unlawful to possess or discharge any firearm, bow and arrow or fireworks
32. Permits may be revoked without refund for failure to follow these rules and regulations and Department of Parks regulations governing all park areas
